NOTES FOR EXHIBITORS

All goat classes are held under the Rules Regulations recognition of the British Goat Society. All exhibits must be registered with the British Goat Society as in the name and ownership of the exhibitor; the registered name, number and earmark being quoted on the entry form, along with kidding dates of goats in milk. All goats in milk must have kidded or aborted at least 30 days prior to the date of the show (16th April 2025). Attached Declaration form must be completed and returned with entries. Kids must be a minimum of 2 months old on day of show. The registration number of any goat initially entered as RAF must be submitted to the show secretary before the goat competes. No pregnant goat may enter the showground. In the event of an unforeseen kidding or abortion taking place, the goat must immediately be isolated from other goats. Full details of goat exhibitor and action taken will be reported in writing by the Chief Steward to the B.G.S Secretary immediately after the show.

C.A.E.

All goats must have a valid C.A.E Whole Herd test certificate and must have tested negative within the last 12 months prior to the show this certificate must be completed on the current Relevant CAE form and include the Veterinary Declaration. The certificate must show the ID mark of the goat. Please note kids must be from a negative tested dam on the form or have a copy of their dams herd test sent in with entry. Exhibitors are asked not to bring to the show any goat that has EVER had a positive reaction to a C.A.E test. Herds will be penned separately where possible

A copy of the current C.A.E whole herd certificate and declaration must accompany your entry.

C.A.E Accredited Exhibitors must on arrival hand to the head steward a copy of health Status Report/Certificates prior to unloading, and all unloading/loading and Parking must be done at designated signed areas.

Arrival will be through Gate 7 (green gate by golf course) and then via the wheel wash at gate 6 then to the far end of the span Building (follow Signs)

All goats in milk must be on the showground by 5.30pm on Friday 16th May 2025 and must be stripped out by the appointed stewards by 6.30pm.

Udder inspection will be 7am on 17th May 2025, immediately followed by milking which must be completed by 8.30 am and all Milkers must be striped again as each are milked.

Evening milking must be completed by 6.30pm.

Udder inspection for the second show on the morning of 18th May 2025 will take place at 7am with final milking taking place straight after and to be completed by 8.30am.

Males will have both days shows judged on Saturday 17th May 2025, male Classes will follow on after all female classes are complete and the 2nd male show will be judged after completion of the first male show. (likely after a lunch break)

Times may vary and breaks may be included subject to Chief Steward and judge's discretion.

IMPORTANT MALE INFO

Those not bringing milkers may just bring males and youngstock on the Day but these Exhibitors must arrive after 9AM (not disturbing milking) and before 11.00am on 17^h May 2025 all of these exhibits will remain in their trailers for the duration of the show.

(Female young stock will only be judged for these exhibitors at the Norwich & District Male and Female show unless staying over till the following day).

Any Males attending with milkers and staying for the weekend will be expected to be penned next to the exhibitors other exhibits for the duration of the show.

Any males causing damage or issues may be asked to be housed in the exhibitors trailer and/or may be asked to be taken home.

Please contact steward on arrival.

Goat ID may be checked.

Exhibitors are asked to use the milking area provided. The pail containing the milk of each exhibit must rest level with the ground and be capable of being carried single handed by a secure handle. The Chief Steward has the right to refuse to allow the use of any container that does not comply. The Show Committee had the right to divide or cancel any class, its decision in this or any other matter is final.
